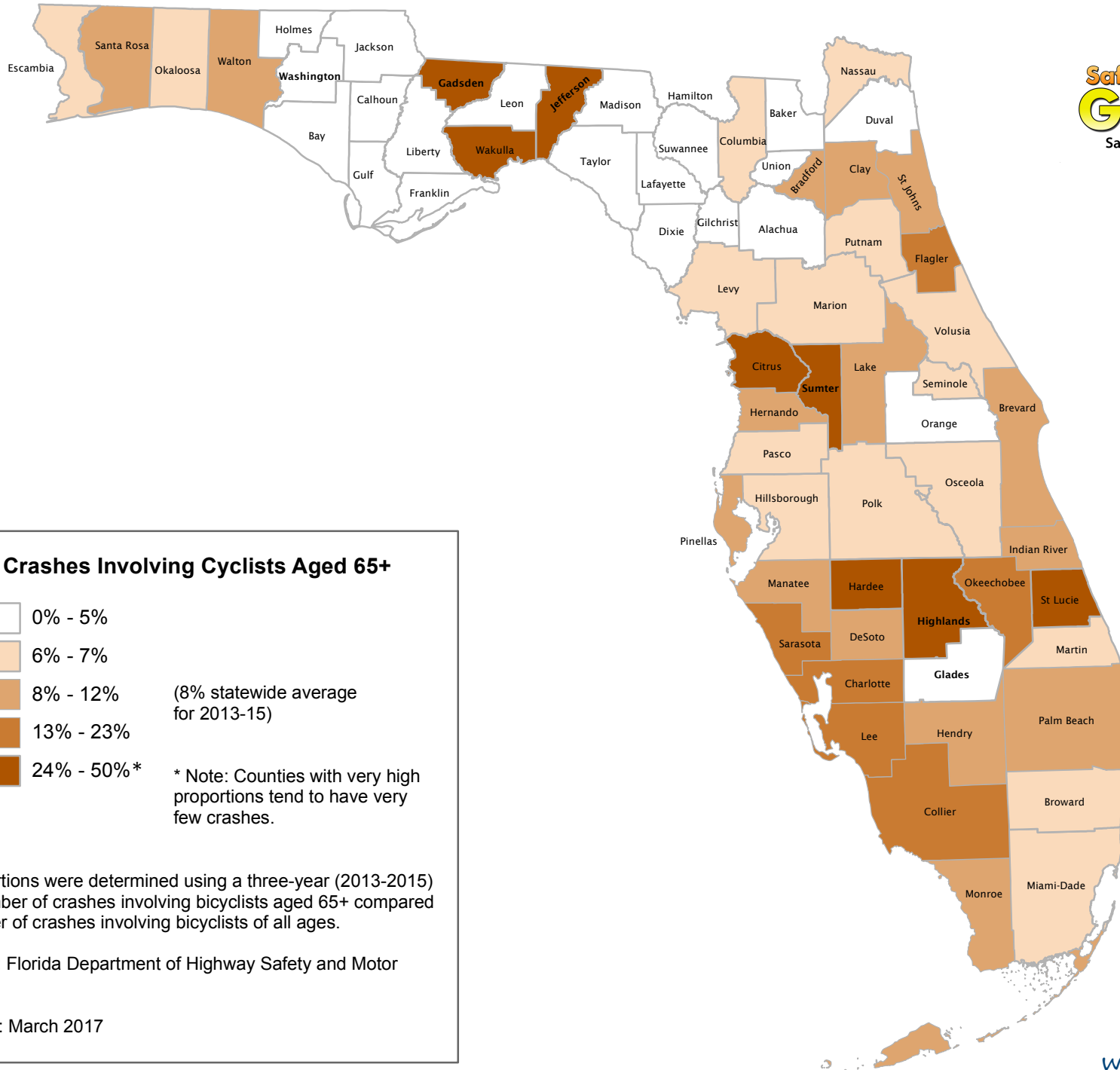


Crashes Involving Bicyclists Aged 65+
